### ROME

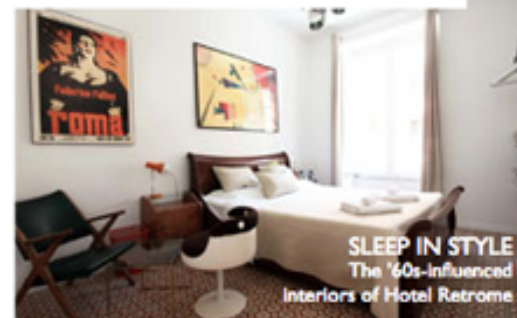
Italy
